
The grapes for this vintage saw more hang time than the prior year, which allowed for steady phenolic development. They were hand harvested, which is never an easy task – especially given that crop levels were slightly above average due to favorable weather conditions. This stability in temperature contributed to wines with heft and helped them retain finesse and natural complexity.

Our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon has aromas of black fruit, violets and a hint of toasted oak. In the mouth, it expresses flavors of blueberries, blackberries, plums, espresso, and hint of dusty earth classic to Cabernets from this region. This wine is aged in French and American oak for 8 months to deliver well-structured tannins and a rounded finish.
