


## SPARKLING BRUT CALIFORNIA

Ca' Momi Sparkling Brut is a blend of Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, and Viognier. We harvest our grapes at lower brix to preserve the bright, fresh flavors and maintain higher acidity. The wine undergoes primary and secondary fermentation in stainless steel tanks using the Charmat method and is then immediately bottled under pressure to preserve its sparkling, fresh acidity, and fruity characteristics.

Our brut sparkling wine has vibrant aromas of Meyer lemon, Bosc pear, green apple, and a hint of vanilla. On the palate, this wine is a symphony of flavors, including bright lemon, creamy butter, and ripe honey crisp apple. It has a luxurious, rich mouthfeel and a long finish. Whether you are celebrating a special occasion or simply enjoying a glass with friends, this is the perfect choice to elevate any moment and celebrate life every day.




# ROSSO CALIFORNIA

Weather during the 2021 growing season was ideal for grape ripening, with mild temperatures near the end of the growing season. Yields were lighter, berries and clusters were smaller; flavors were more complex and expressive due to the extended hang time. This was an excellent vintage.

Our Rosso boasts complex aromas of raspberry, plum, balsamic and coffee. On the palate, flavors of ripe red berries, cherries, and hints of vanilla. Aged in brandy barrels to add depth to the wine, infusing it with a subtle array of oak notes including caramel, vanilla, and cigar box. Overall, this wine is a testament to its complexity and elegance.




# 2022 SAUVIGNON BLANC MONTEREY

Harvest 2022 began almost two weeks earlier than usual. Grapes were night harvested, since cooler temperatures preserve both acidity and freshness of flavors as well as prevent the start of fermentation. Warmer summer temperatures and sustained highs, combined with a lack of rainfall, resulted in smaller grape cluster sizes and overall yield. The end result is a Sauvignon Blanc with depth, refreshing flavor and timeless style.

Our Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of citrus, tropical fruit and golden delicious apples, with a light green herbal note classic to the Monterey AVA. On the palate, flavors of citrus, apples and pears are balanced by fresh, lively acidity. This crisp, fresh wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks, giving it acidity, balance, and a clean and persistent finish.




# 2022 CHARDONNAY NAPA VALLEY

2022 was one of the more unique vintages in recent history, one that winemakers have dubbed "a tale of two harvests". Bud break timing was in March and spring weather conditions were typical. Summer months offered warm days and cool nights ideal for grape ripening. Then in September, we experienced a 5-day heat wave with triple digit temperatures, resulting in an earlier harvest than anticipated. Rains followed the heat wave, putting a temporary halt to picking, so harvest was completed in two stages. Overall yields were lower but quality was excellent and we saw greater concentration and flavor intensity. Our Carneros Chardonnay was harvested on October 4th.

Our Napa Valley Chardonnay has aromas of Meyer lemon, pear with a subtle hint of vanilla. On the palate, a delightful creamy texture and balanced acidity, with a burst of refreshing flavors including apple, lemon, pineapple and tropical fruit. The finish is pleasantly persistent, with the fruit flavors lingering on the palate.




# 2022 MERLOT NAPA VALLEY

2022 was one of the more unique vintages in recent history, one that winemakers have dubbed "a tale of two harvests". Bud break timing was in March and spring weather conditions were typical. Summer months offered warm days and cool nights ideal for grape ripening. Then in September, we experienced a 5-day heat wave with triple digit temperatures, resulting in an earlier harvest than anticipated. Rains followed the heat wave, putting a temporary halt to picking, so harvest was completed in two stages. Overall yields were lower but quality was excellent and we saw greater concentration and flavor intensity. Our Carneros Merlot was harvested on October 21st.

Our Napa Valley Merlot entices with aromas of ripe blueberry, luscious blackberry, and a touch of cocoa. On the palate, flavors of blackberry and plum intertwine with hints of brown sugar and a hint of vanilla. This wine has a weighty mid-palate, medium tannins and a long finish.




# CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

The 2021 growing season was colder than average. A dry spring gave way to summer growing conditions that were ideal for berry development. September was warm, and as a result, harvest started early. Yields were below average, but from a quality standpoint, it was an outstanding vintage!

Our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a full-bodied wine with a dark, inky red color. On the nose, it offers a nice balance of traditional Cabernet characteristics with aromas of black fruit, cocoa and cinnamon, with flavors of toasty oak, vanilla bean, and huckleberry compote. This wine is aged in French and American oak for 8 months. Bold tannins and a lingering finish make this a complex and satisfying wine.




# 2022 PINOT NOIR NAPA VALLEY

2022 was one of the more unique vintages in recent history, one that winemakers have dubbed "a tale of two harvests". Bud break timing was in March and spring weather conditions were typical. Summer months offered warm days and cool nights ideal for grape ripening. Then in September, we experienced a 5-day heat wave with triple digit temperatures, resulting in an earlier harvest than anticipated. Rains followed the heat wave, putting a temporary halt to picking, so harvest was completed in two stages. Overall yields were lower but quality was excellent and we saw greater concentration and flavor intensity. Our Carneros Pinot Noir was harvested on September 8th.

Our Napa Valley Pinot Noir captivates with enticing aromas of ripe raspberries, cherry, earthiness, vanilla and baking spices. On the palate, there are flavors of Bing cherry, raspberries and rhubarb pie, along with nutmeg and clove. This wine has balanced tannins and acidity, with an elegant mouthfeel that leads to a satisfying finish that leaves you craving another sip.
